

ORDINANCE NO. 2-1954

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AND ASSESSING FOR GENERAL REVENUE
PURPOSES A PER CAPITAL TAX OF \$2.50
UPON ALL ADULT PERSONS RESIDING WITHIN THE LIMITS OF MOUNT PLEASANT TOWNSHIP,
COLUMBIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township, Columbia County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That the Board of Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township, Columbia County, Pennsylvania, a political sub-division constituting a second-class township within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, does under and pursuant to authority granted to it by the Act of June 25, 1947, P. L. 1145, and its amendments, levy and assess for general revenue purposes, a per capita tax of \$2.50 on all adult persons residing within the limits of Mount Pleasant Township, Columbia County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and legal publication.
