

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT PLEASANT, COUNTY OF COLUMBIA
AND STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA

ORDINANCE NO. 24—1987

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS OF THIRTY-FIVE (35) MILES PER HOUR ALONG CERTAIN PORTIONS OF TOWNSHIP ROAD T-519 (MELICK HOLLOW ROAD), TWENTY-FIVE (25) MILES PER HOUR ALONG CERTAIN PORTIONS OF TOWNSHIP ROAD T-495 AND T-426 (THOMAS ROAD), TWENTY-FIVE (25) MILES PER HOUR ALONG A PORTION OF TOWNSHIP ROAD T-502 (WHITES CHURCH ROAD), THIRTY-FIVE (35) MILES PER HOUR AND FIFTEEN (15) MILES PER HOUR ALONG CERTAIN PORTIONS OF TOWNSHIP ROAD T-519 AND T-508 (DOG PATCH HOLLOW ROAD), AND TWENTY-FIVE (25) MILES PER HOUR ALONG A PORTION OF TOWNSHIP ROAD T-495 (ENGLISH HILL ROAD).

The following is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Mount Pleasant, Columbia County, Pennsylvania, and the same is hereby enacted by authority of the same:

- a. Maximum speed limits are established on portions of specified streets, as follows, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle, on any part of a street where a maximum speed limit applies, at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that part of the street:

STREET	BETWEEN	MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT
1. T-519 (Melick Hollow Road)	L.R. 19029 & State Route 42	Thirty-five (35) Miles Per Hour
2. T-495 & T-426 (Thomas Road)	L.R. 19029 & L.R. 19026	Twenty-five (25) Miles Per Hour
3. T-502 (Whites Church Road)	L.R. 12029 & L.R. 19105	Twenty-five (25) Miles Per Hour
4. T-519 & T-508 (Dog Patch Hollow Road)	T-519 & L.R. 19030	Thirty-five (35) Miles Per Hour except on several sharp turns, it is Fifteen (15) Miles Per Hour
5. T-495 (English Hill Road)	L.R. 19029 & L.R. 19105	Twenty-five (25) Miles Per Hour
