ORDINANCE NO. 1987—25

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS OF THIRTY-FIVE (35)
MILES PER HOUR ALONG TOWNSHIP ROADS T-600 (ROBBINS ROAD) AND T-559
(WELLIVERSVILLE ROAD)

The following is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of
Mount Pleasant, Columbia County, Pennsylvania, and the same is hereby enacted by authority of the
same:

- a. Maximum speed limits are established on certain roads as follows, and it shall be unlawful
for any person to drive a vehicle, on any part of a street where the maximum speed limit
applies, at a higher speed than the maximum prescribes for that part of the street:

| Street | Between | Maximum Speed Limit |
|-----------------------------------|--------------------------------|---------------------------------|
| 1. T-600 (Robbins Road) | LR 19029 to RT. 42 | Thirty-Five (35) Miles Per Hour |
| 2. T-559 (Welliversville Road) | LR 19029 to Orange Township | Thirty-Five (35) Miles Per Hour |
