

ORDINANCE OF MOUNT PLEASANT TOWNSHIP, COLUMBIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

ORDINANCE NO. 1988—27

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT PLEASANT, COLUMBIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF GARBAGE AND REFUSE HAULERS TO REQUIRE THAT ALL GARBAGE AND REFUSE HAULERS DELIVER SOLID WASTE ONLY TO LYCOMING COUNTY'S MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE FACILITY OR FACILITIES.

Whereas, assuring adequate disposal of garbage, rubbish, refuse and other waste materials collected within the Township of Mount Pleasant is related to the health, welfare and safety of the citizen's of said Township; and

Whereas, the Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township desire to enact an Ordinance pursuant to an agreement entered into by and between Mount Pleasant Township and Lycoming County, which agreement will provide assurances of an adequate disposal site for garbage, rubbish, refuse and other waste materials, during the term of said agreement provided that all solid waste collected within said Township is disposed of at the Lycoming County Facility or Facilities;

Now, therefore, be it enacted and ordained by the Township of Mount Pleasant, Columbia County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

- A. From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, all collectors and/or haulers of Municipal Solid Waste, which shall include all garbage, rubbish, refuse and other waste materials, which has its place of origin Mount Pleasant Township, Columbia County, Pennsylvania, shall deliver such waste only to Lycoming County's Municipal Solid Waste Facility or Facilities upon such terms, conditions and at such fees as Lycoming County shall establish.
- B. Any Ordinance or resolution inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed.
- C. This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date permitted under law following its enactment and shall remain in full force until modified, amended or rescinded by the Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township.
