

## **Mount Pleasant Township Minutes of June 4, 2012**

The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Wagner called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Wagner, and Gordner; and Secretary Kindt.

### MINUTES

Minutes were presented for May 2012 meeting. Correction to minutes...Zoning report should state 1171 Millville Road, not Millertown Road. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Motion carried.

### FINANCIAL REPORT

Financials were reviewed. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

### REPORTS

#### Road Foreman

-55 hours road maintenance including grading, rolling, mowing, cleaning ditches, placing rip-rap at pipes. Three trees removed from roadways. One and one-half ton cold patch applied.

-4 hours on maintenance of equipment.

-Quotes received for crack seal application for Mellick Hollow Road. Keystone Paving \$6160; Robert Young \$9690; HRI Midland \$6000; Floyd Fry \$2800. Supervisors concerned that Fry bid was not realistic. HRI is doing the fiber seal. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to award bid to Midland (HRI), seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

-Quotes to repair base, widen and replace five pipes on Mordansville Road. Sokol \$8700; Robert Young \$5145; G & M Crawford \$4380. Supervisor Wagner made motion to award to Crawford, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Motion carried.

#### Community Center

Supervisor Fenstermacher updated wiring in basement for sump pump and dehumidifier.

#### Secretary

Reviewing provisions for Act 13 which deals with well drilling damage to bridges, etc.
