

Mount Pleasant Township Minutes of July 2, 2012

The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Wagner called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Wagner, and Gordner; and Secretary Kindt.

MINUTES

Minutes were presented for June 2012 meeting. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Financials were reviewed. Secretary contacted PPL to remove malfunctioning light on pole in Community Center parking lot. Removal will save approximately \$17 per month in electric charges. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Road Foreman

-190 hours road maintenance including grading, rolling, mowing, cleaning ditches, cutting up downed trees.

-7 hours on maintenance of equipment.

-3 hours office work.

Five pipes replaced on Mordansville Road by G.M. Crawford. HRI will start road work on Thursday. Base repair and widening. Oil and chip started today. Oman is completed. Turner High View tomorrow. Resident Turner reported Ellis Turner Road needs extensive work. Supervisor Wagner stated pipes cannot be replaced unless approved by State Engineer. Pipe installed by Sokol on McWilliams Road is settling. Resident Sitler suggested more permanent repairs be made to Peacock Corners Road, not just patching. Resident Hock questioned why road work is not put out for bid. Supervisor Fenstermacher suggested soliciting bids to determine if cost effective.

Exterminator did semi-annual treatment. Old microwave replaced. Solution to Community Center window problem moving forward.

Correspondence

-Columbia County Department of Public Safety will offer a SkyWarn Storm Spotter training Wednesday, July 18 at 6:30pm on Sawmill Road.

-The Department also issued a notice that Columbia County has been designated a Primary Disaster Area by the USDA. Assistance is available to farmers and ranchers through Federal programs.

Old Business

Supervisor Wagner opened bids for equipment available for sale...two 500 gallon oil tanks (one w/pump and one without), an old generator, and military trailer. Sulli Motors of the Pittsburgh area submitted a bid of \$178 for generator only. Mike Veneziano of Bellefonte submitted a bid of \$151 for generator; tank w/pump \$201; tank w/o pump \$100.10; trailer \$51. Supervisor Gordner suggested checking on scraping equipment if worth more as scrap. Supervisor Wagner made motion to reject bids, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Motion carried. Supervisors will check Township code to see if equipment can legally be disposed of as scrap.

New Business

-Resolution 68-12 to allow Secretary to file State reports electronically. Supervisor Wagner made motion to pass, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

-\$23,000 received from Dirt & Gravel Grant Program for Rote Hollow Road repairs.

-Stream repairs previously discussed to nine properties being handled by Conservation District. Township may be asked to help pay advertising costs.
