-Supervisor Gordner reported Township is low on cinders. Geisinger has purchased entire supply from Township's previous source. Gordner contacted HRI to order anti-skid through the State contract.

-Resident Black reported on a problem affecting fire/emergency calls. The roads that are not maintained, and therefore impassable for emergency vehicles are not clearly marked on any map. Black will work with County after securing a list from the Road Foreman.
