

Mount Pleasant Township Minutes of June 2, 2014

The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Fenstermacher called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Robbins, Gordner, and Secretary Kindt.

MINUTES

Minutes were presented for May 2014 meeting. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Robbins. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Financials were reviewed. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Robbins. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Road Foreman

-Approximately 100 hours on road work including dragging and rolling Lamoreaux, Fester, Hogs Back, and Kyttle . Applied 20 tons of cold patch on Oman, McWilliams, Robbins, Rhodomoyer and Hillside.
-Equipment repaired: 97 truck with brake problems and 2012 truck with battery problems.

Zoning Officer; Not in attendance.

Community Center

Secretary asked that computer table be moved to better observe security monitor while working in office. Supervisor Fenstermacher will move wires.

Secretary; Correspondence: Nothing to report.

Old Business:

Information received from PEMA regarding 1190 Millville Road vacant lot. May be transferred to non-profit groups (i.e.) Sportsmen's Clubs; Trout Unlimited, etc. No permanent structures permissible. Supervisor Fenstermacher questioned Stillwater Church using ball fields. Secretary stated the church group asked permission.

New Business:

-The amount the Township will receive from the \$200,000 Centax settlement will be \$1,869.33.
-One bid was received from Hammaker East for the road work that was advertised. After opening the bid, a motion to table was made by Supervisor Gordner, seconded by Supervisor Robbins until the Supervisors could review the bid more closely. Motion carried.

Public Participation:

Resident Paul Heaps expressed concern that a compressor station for the proposed Williams gas line will be built approximately a half mile from his property. He was also concerned about the safety record of the Williams Gas Company. Many severe incidents have occurred in other areas. He asked that the Supervisors stay informed and remain cautious.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Gordner, seconded by Supervisor Robbins to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:50pm.
