

# Mount Pleasant Township

## Minutes of May 5, 2014

The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Fenstermacher called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Robbins, Gordner, and Secretary Kindt.

### MINUTES

Minutes were presented for April 2014 meeting. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Robbins. Motion carried.

### AUDITORS

Ann Hess reported the audit was completed in February. No exceptions were found.

### FINANCIAL REPORT

Financials were reviewed. Additional invoices for approval to Fruits Fuel Service for \$517.59, Starr Portables \$135.00 and Trustees Insurance for dental \$979.44. Supervisor Robbins made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

### REPORTS

#### Road Foreman

-83 hours on road work including dragging road and cleaning pipes. Replaced pipes on Rote Hollow, Lick Run and two pipes on Shaner Road.

-11 hours on maintenance of equipment.

Zoning Officer; Not in attendance.

#### Community Center

Water heater for rest rooms needs to be replaced. Water very rusty. Supervisor Fenstermacher will check into replacement.

Secretary; Nothing to report.

#### Correspondence:

Letter from Orangeville Library thanking Township for \$250 donation.

#### Old Business:

\$17,102.07 received from State for costs related to demolition of 1190 Millville Road due to flood. Property now belongs to Township. Must appeal taxes for next year. Will check with Commissioner Young and fire company to see if Township can donate parcel.

#### New Business:

-\$27,195 Grant received from County for Rote Hollow project. Consultant Wagner stated estimated cost of pipe \$5300 and \$9000 to install. Two feet of shale must cover pipe. Wagner will apply for permit. All metal pipes need to be replaced. Work completed to date can be used as in kind contribution toward Grant. Supervisor Fenstermacher questioned if more grant money might be available.

-Township must adopt resolution for County grant. Supervisor Gordner made motion to adopt Resolution 84-14, seconded by Supervisor Robbins. Motion carried.

-A PennDOT representative assisted the Township in checking roads for repair. It was suggested to bid out all road work separately, then determine which projects were affordable. Seal coat may be cost more than PennDOT anticipated.

-Supervisor Robbins stated Robbins Road needs additional repair from Kindt Road to Rt 42. The work should consist of patching, rolling, then tar and chip.

-Road Foreman Gordner reported a Lick Run Road resident paved driveway without checking with the Township. Drive is causing water runoff problems. Adjoining driveway is causing problems as well.

Public Participation:

No one had any comments.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Fenstermacher, seconded by Supervisor Robbins to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:40pm.
