

## **Mount Pleasant Township Minutes of December 8, 2014**

The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Fenstermacher called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Robbins, Gordner, and Secretary Kindt.

### MINUTES

Minutes were presented for November 2014 meeting. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Robbins. Motion carried.

### FINANCIAL REPORT

Financials were reviewed. Additional invoice for approval to PSATS for dues \$809.00. Supervisor Robbins made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

### REPORTS

#### Road Foreman:

Completed project on Rote Hollow Road; Plow; Cinder; Replace radiator on roller.

#### Zoning Officer:

Not in attendance.

#### Community Center:

- Roof repaired temporarily. Will need to be replaced within two years.
- Rental on December 13.
- Water heater for rest rooms defective. Company will not warranty. Heater will be replaced.

#### Secretary:

- Over 400 emails sent to Township opposing pipeline.

#### Correspondence:

None.

#### Old Business:

- Supervisor Robbins made motion to adopt 2015 budget, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. \$10,000 additional funds put into road wages. Motion carried.
- MS-999 report completed and sent to Municipal Services for Rote Hollow project reimbursement.
- The washout situation on Thomas Road was inspected. It was determined the cinder blocks would not be a good solution. It was suggested that large rip-rap be placed and work on the ditch to help with run off.

#### New Business:

- Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to adopt Resolution 88-14 to Appoint County for Tax Collection, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.
- Motion was made by Supervisor Fenstermacher to adopt Resolution 89-14 for expenditure of Act 13 Funds for 2014 seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.
- Motion was made by Supervisor Fenstermacher to advertise the Township's intent to adopt an ordinance for participation in PSATS Unemployment Compensation Fund and also PSATS Health Trust Fund. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Robbins. Motion carried. Ordinances are available for inspection until passage at the January 5, 2015 meeting.

Public Participation:

-Resident Winn complained about the way snow was plowed near his property. Sod was thrown into his yard. Supervisor Robbins will inspect and possibly repair. It was suggested that roads be measured 33 feet from the center of the road and all sod be removed from the Township right of way.

-Complaints that Rote Hollow Project should have had a longer pipe and road should have been widened.

-Resident Lyons discussed the opposition to the pipeline. Supervisors stated they will need more education and facts before they decide the pros and cons of the project. Lyons offered to share any information with the Supervisors or any resident who is concerned. Lyons stated the Township does have the authority to go against the Federal government on this issue.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Gordner, seconded by Supervisor Robbins to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:29pm.
