The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Fenstermacher called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Robbins, Gordner, and Secretary Kindt.

MINUTES

Minutes were presented for November 2015 meeting. Supervisor Robbins made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Financials reviewed. Supervisor Robbins made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Road Foreman:

- Downed trees removed; open ditches; equipment maintenance. Front hitch for 2012 Ford missing. New part ordered.

Zoning Officer:

Community Center:

- Roof replacement scheduled to begin December 8. Dumpster at shed will be moved to Community Center.

Secretary:

- Registration for PSATS Spring Conference available January 12. Not sure who will attend.

CORRESPONDENCE:

Notice from PSATS regarding classes for new supervisors. Incumbents also urged to attend due to change in laws. Classes scheduled in January, February and March. Secretary will check dates and locations.

OLD BUSINESS:

Supervisor Robbins made motion to adopt 2016 budget, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

-Dates will be advertised for 2016 meetings for Supervisors, Auditors and Planning Commission.

-Resolution 91-15 setting the RE and Per Capita tax rates. No change for 2016. Supervisor Robbins made motion to adopt, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

-Resolution 92-15 appointing County as tax collector. A resident elected to the post declined the appointment. Therefore, the Township will remain with County for collection. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to adopt, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

-A resolution to set the commission rate for any elected tax collector at .02 was tabled.

-First Keystone CD renewal by 12/17/15. Discussed transferring to General Fund for cinder shed.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:

-Resident George Crawford elected Auditor in November. He indicated he is declining appointment.

-Resident Sitler and others thanked departing Supervisor Fenstermacher for his service. Supervisor Fenstermacher offered to help Township with repairs, etc.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Fenstermacher, seconded by Supervisor Robbins to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:18pm.
