The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Fenstermacher called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Robbins, Gordner, and Secretary Kindt.

MINUTES

Minutes were presented for May 2015 meeting. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Robbins. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Financials were reviewed. Supervisor Robbins made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Road Foreman:

-Run ditcher; open pipes; haul stone; put up signs; had mower repaired; mowed roads; worked on equipment; filled pot holes; removed downed tree; attended equipment show, no Township vehicle mileage or worker time charged; received call about pipe on Ellis Turner Road being too narrow for emergency tankers during Turner fire.
-Asked EMC Black to map out sources of water that can be used during fire emergencies. Resident McElwee questioned if Township could use water at HRI. Water available to Township but not always accessible.

Zoning Officer:

Not in attendance. Supervisor Fenstermacher reported a carport on Crawford Road was built with no permit.

Community Center: -Nothing to report.

Secretary: -Nothing to Report

Correspondence: -None to report.

Old Business:

-Quote from Dent for water pipe replacement was tabled.
-Donation to Sheriff Association was again discussed. Supervisors felt money would not be used locally. Supervisor Robbins made motion not to donate, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

Public Participation:

-Resident McElwee reported the demolition is complete at the former Greenly property on Robbins Road. He requested a letter stating that the Supervisors were satisfied with the work done. Supervisor Gordner made motion to supply letter, seconded by Supervisor Robbins. Motion carried.
-Resident Hock stated County Home Road is in need of repairs. Ditches are very deep.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Gordner, seconded by Supervisor Robbins to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:15pm.
