The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Fenstermacher called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Robbins, Gordner, and Secretary Kindt.

MINUTES

Minutes were presented for April 2015 meeting. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Robbins. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Financials were reviewed. Supervisor Robbins made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Road Foreman:

-Spread 18 ton of cold patch; Grade roads; Clean pipes; look for missing signs. Replaced fuel and hydraulic lines on grader.
-Had several calls asking why Supervisors did not let residents know about Home Rule issue. Supervisor Gordner stated none of the Supervisors were informed by the Home Rule group about this issue. Residents felt blindsided. The presentation by PSATS at VoTech indicated Home Rule will not stop pipeline. Residents that contacted Supervisor Gordner felt a small group of people are speaking for the Township with nothing to say.

-Water pipes will be replaced.

Correspondence:

-Stillwater Christian Church requested permission to use ball field at Community Center. A certificate of insurance has been supplied. Supervisor Gordner made motion to grant permission, seconded by Supervisor Robbins. Motion carried.

-Columbia County Traveling Library buying new unit and has asked for input into what residents would like included. Contact Bloomsburg Public Library.
-PEMA sending final reimbursement for 2011 flood in the amount of \$498.58.

-Robbins Subdivision plans were reviewed. Plan previously been reviewed by Planning Commission. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Supervisor Robbins abstained. Motion carried.

-Jai Robbins Planning Waiver & Non-Building Declaration was reviewed. Supervisor Gordner made motion to pass, seconded by Supervisor Fenstermacher. Supervisor Robbins abstained. Motion carried.
-Zoning Book needs to be updated. Has not been updated since 2001-2002. Jerry Walls will assist.
-Planning Commission Chairman Gary Sitler announced he will resign as of May 4, 2015 citing time involved and health issues. He indicated he will assist Jerry Walls on a part time basis. The Board and several residents thanked Gary for his 30+ years of service.

Public Participation:

-Resident questioned when basketball backboard would be repaired.
-Resident Hornberger indicated Home Rule stopped pipeline in State College
-Resident Jon Turner stated that this country will benefit from the sale of this pipeline gas even if it is shipped abroad.
-Resident Crawford questioned the route of the pipeline.
-Resident Minto stated the pipeline will be 300 feet from his property and has concerns.
-Resident Schlichter questioned if Mt Pleasant election board would be assisting with questions. Resident Sitler indicated this is not permitted.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Gordner, seconded by Supervisor Robbins to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:20pm.
