

Mount Pleasant Township Minutes of November 3, 2014

The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Fenstermacher called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Robbins, Gordner, and Secretary Kindt.

MINUTES

Minutes were presented for October 2014 meeting. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Robbins. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Financials were reviewed. Supervisor Robbins made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Road Foreman

- Work at shop; Clean out spreaders; Mow roads; clean ditches; put up road signs; hauled fill on Rote Hollow Road.
- Met with Williams Pipeline representative.
- Interviewed part time work applicants: Roy Whitmoyer; Sam Robbins; Jai Robbins; Nelson Shurman.

Zoning Officer:

Not in attendance.

Community Center ;

- Shingles loose on roof.

Secretary :

- Paperwork complete for Greenly property tax exoneration. Less than \$90 owed to Township.
- Tax exoneration hearing for 1190 Millville Road property held October 30. Vacant lot has been removed from tax rolls.
- PEMA/FEMA will be working on closing out flood property paperwork for 1190 Millville Road on November 19.

Correspondence:

PENNDOT sent letter notifying townships that Bureau of General Services has been abolished. Services have been integrated into the Office of Planning Deputate. Township representative Greg Dibble indicated his job functions will not change at this time. Secretary will check with Senator Gordner's office on what this may mean to Township.

Old Business

- Rote Hollow work to be completed November 4, weather permitting.
- Job applicants need to come into office to complete application process. Supervisor Gordner made motion to hire the four applicants for emergency work, seconded by Supervisor Robbins. Motion carried.

New Business:

- Three driveway permits issued for Flick subdivision.
- Motion was made to adopt the preliminary 2015 budget by Supervisor Robbins, seconded by Supervisor

Fenstermacher. Motion carried.

-Motion was made to adopt Resolution 87-14 to set tax levy for 2015 by Supervisor Gordner, seconded by Supervisor Robbins. Motion carried. Taxes will remain at 1.151 mills and \$5 per capita for 2015.

Public Participation:

-Supervisor Gordner asked residents if disruption from exploding targets had diminished. He spoke to the property owner which seemed to help the situation.

-Back Branch detour has been determined. Detour will not use Oman Road.

-Thomas Road resident questioned when large pipe would be fixed so water would not wash out bank. Supervisor Robbins suggested using cinder blocks stacked three high to alleviate problem. Will need excavator to place blocks. Project will be considered for next year.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Fenstermacher, seconded by Supervisor Robbins to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:35pm.
