

Mount Pleasant Township Minutes of October 6, 2014

The Supervisors of Mt Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Fenstermacher called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Robbins, Gordner, and Secretary Kindt.

MINUTES

Minutes of previous meeting were reviewed. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Robbins. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Financials were reviewed. Check to Dent Plumbing will be held until problem with rusty water is corrected. Supervisor Fenstermacher will contact Dent. Supervisor Fenstermacher made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Road Foreman

- Paving, oil and chip completed. Pot holes repaired. Mowing and tree removal.
- Problem with tires on Lick Run and Mount Pleasant Road may be solved. Supervisor Gordner contacted person doing the dumping.
- Put road signs back up knocked down by vandals. Signs missing on Crouse Hollow and Huckelberry.
- Pipe on Rote Hollow Road to be replaced Monday (weather permitting) with County grant money. Road will be closed from Kytte to Johnson.
- Began interviews for part time help. One applicant (Whitmoyer) was interviewed.

Zoning Officer; Not in attendance.

Community Center ; Rental on Saturday.

Secretary; Nothing to report.

Correspondence: YMCA sent letter to thank Township for use of the ball fields.

Old Business:

- Rote Hollow project discussed earlier.
- Supervisor Fenstermacher discussed the Back Branch bridge replacement. Oman Road will not be used as a detour. He requested that PennDOT to cut back the bank and place a "no parking" to increase visibility at the intersection with Whites Church Road. PennDOT will get back to the Township with answers.

New Business: Resolution 86-14 to exonerate all back taxes owed to the Township by the Greenly estate.

Public Participation:

- Several residents attended meeting to complain about the explosives being discharged near Crawford Road. The target shooting is not in question, just loud explosives. Residents once again questioned adopting a noise ordinance. Residents were advised to contact property owners (Robbins) to discuss a solution. Supervisor Fenstermacher will also ask the owners to be considerate of the neighbors.
- Residents questioned legality of trash burning on Crawford Road. Township has an ordinance against burning anything other than leaves and branches.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Gordner, seconded by Supervisor Robbins to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:25pm.
