

Mount Pleasant Township Minutes of October 5, 2015

The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Fenstermacher called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Robbins, Gordner, and Secretary Kindt.

MINUTES

Minutes were presented for September 2015 meeting. Supervisor Gordner made motion to approve, seconded by Supervisor Robbins. Motion carried.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Financials were reviewed. Supervisor Robbins made motion to approve financials, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

REPORTS

Road Foreman:

-Arranged for inspection of 97 truck and International truck. Put hood on roller. Put up sign on Hogs Back Road. Pick up signs on berm of road at Turner High View. No additional work completed due to budget constraints.

Zoning Officer:

-Not in attendance.

Community Center:

- Quotes were solicited to replace shingle roof. WTC Contracting only quote received. The Supervisors decided a metal roof replacement would be preferable. WTC submitted proposal for metal roof at \$34,200+-. WTC is local and would stand by his work. This work does not require quotes. Second Class Township code 3102 subsection (h-1) states "...emergence or routine maintenance, repairs or replacements for.....and other public works of the township if they do not constitute new additions, extensions or enlargements of existing facilities and equipment". Supervisor Robbins made motion to accept WTC proposal, seconded by Supervisor Gordner. Motion carried.

Secretary:

-Secretary reported receiving notice that Liquid Fuels for 2016 will be \$146,419.29 or nearly a \$18,000 increase over 2015.

CORRESPONDENCE:

-Bill Lowthert of the Town of Bloomsburg contacted the township regarding a collaborative effort to address the MS4 correspondence from DEP. The MS4 deals with storm water and the new DEP guidelines which will have to be addressed. Supervisors feel it would be beneficial to share the expense if the Township must comply. The mandate is directed toward urban areas and there is a question as to whether the Township has any urbanized areas.

OLD BUSINESS:

-Secretary will contact Attorney Wiley to request his presence at the October 29 Planning meeting at 7pm.

NEW BUSINESS:

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:

Resident Edgar reported burning again next to his residence. Pictures were introduced dated September 17, 2015. Supervisors will meet once more neighbor. The Supervisors wish to avoid legal action if possible.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Fenstermacher, seconded by Supervisor Robbins to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:31pm.
