

Mt Pleasant Township Minutes from Sept 12, 2016 Supervisors Meeting

- Meeting was called to order by Chairman McWilliams. Those present were: McWilliams, Gordner, B. Robbins and Secretary M. Robbins.

- First item on the agenda was to open the bids for the Ellis Turner Project. Eight bids were opened and amounts were read in front of the public and then given to John Coleman and his wife to take back to the secretary's office for further consideration.

- Minutes: August minutes were presented and approved by Gordner and seconded by B. Robbins. Motion carried.

- Treasurers Report: There was not an unpaid bills report as bills were already posted and checks were presented at table to be signed by supervisors.

- Township Report: Supervisor Gordner reported that they mowed and opened ditches and also cut several trees and cleaned brush on a number of township roads that included Mellick Hollow Rd., Boudman Rd., Blacks Rd., Kashner, Peacock Corners Rd., Welliversville Rd., Rote Rd., Oman Rd., Coleman Hollow Rd., and Ikeler Rd. They also worked on Shatz Rd. and Huckleberry Rd. to install pipes. Cold patch was applied to Ellis Turner Rd. Chain saw was fixed and bushings replaced on the loader. Eight loads of stone were delivered to the Township shed.

- Supervisors took a short break to confer with Mr. Coleman and his wife regarding a decision on the bids tonight. The consensus was to table this issue until the next meeting where they will announce the selected bidder.
