## **SUPERVISORS MEETING MINUTES FROM SEPTEMBER 11, 2017**

Meeting called to order: 7:00 pm by Chairman McWilliams. Those present were: McWilliams, Gordner, B. Robbins, W. Westover and public attendance seven (7).

Pledge of Allegiance

Moment of Silence: Remembrance of September 11, 2001

Personnel Matters: Secretary Westover off majority of August for family issue while still trying to handle voicemails, emails and urgent issues.

Minutes: Motion by Gordner to approve August minutes, second by B. Robbins, All in favor.

Treasurers Report: Motion by B. Robbins to approve the Treasurer's report, second by Gordner, All in favor.

Township Reports: Road Foreman-Not working many hours due to budget concerns, open ditches, fill pot holes, trees down.

Zoning Officer-2 permits issued, Letter to the Editor.

Community Center-4 Rentals, but 1 Rental conflict. Two rentals same day, regular yearly rental not listed in calendar. New rental moved to Jerseytown: \$50 more, \$50 deposit, and had ad in paper so had to mail change in location to family members (resolve by \$150 refund, \$50 inconvenience fee, gift certificate for 1 rental free in 2018) Motion by B. Robbins to approve steps to resolve, second by McWilliams, All in Favor. Three Thank you notes received: Bloom Y for field, Millville Administration for use of hall, Crawford's appreciation for assistance with bereavement meal which included a \$50 donation.

Old Business: Township established in 1818: thoughts, ideas, and committee members on Celebration 2018 for 200 year mark.

New Business: Oman Subdivision-approved by Planning Commission, except notation of possible land lock of lot in future. Motion by B. Robbins to approve their recommendation, second by Gordner, All in favor.

Williams-sent \$5,000 bond escrow check. Next step, they video record the roadways and their condition prior to starting in Township.

For the Good (Public Participation): Concerns over trees hitting school bus on Mordansville Road. Financials: who handling taxes (secretary/treasurer), being done in house (yes), reconciling bank statements (secretary/treasurer, now bonded, reports attached every month), Liquid Fuels Audit 2016 (working on), CPA/Audit taking so long (yes, first time professional audit), hourly or contract price (contract \$5700), Auditors next year (yes), only costs \$100 then (too many issues). More mowing (some, State has cut back, watching budget still, concern of unmowed grass on turn on Peacock Corners Road (Gordner will look at )
