## Minutes of August 4, 2014

The Supervisors of Mount Pleasant Township held the regular monthly meeting on the above date. Chairman Fenstermacher called the meeting to order at 7pm. Those present: Supervisors Fenstermacher, Robbins, Gordner, and Secretary Kindt.

### MINUTES

### REPORTS

#### Road Foreman

-Mowing, patching holes, open pipes. Repairs to Schatz Road. Removed downed trees on Crawford; Turner High View; Lick Run; Johnson; McWilliams and Thomas Road.

Secretary read report: During the months of January through July, 10 permits were issued. Three were for accessory structures, one mobile home, two pools, one commercial timber harvesting and three additions.

- Three applications received for job opening. Supervisors will review and interview.

#### New Business:

-Supervisor Robbins requested copies of repair invoices for equipment. Secretary can track repairs through Quick Books.

#### Public Participation:

- Resident Carr had questions about history of Township. Carr asked permission to use Community Center as a workshop to put together a historical calendar which they will offer for sale. Resident Sitler questioned if the group could combine the project to produce a book/calendar for the bicentennial in 2018. Motion by Supervisor Fenstermacher, seconded by Supervisor Gordner to allow use of Center as long as it does not interfere with rentals. Motion carried.
- Resident Crawford questioned if State would be repairing pipe and ditch on Ellis Turner Road. Supervisor Gordner will inspect. Supervisor Fenstermacher suggested trying again to obtain permit from State for Township to fix. He suggested Crawford contact Representative Millard for assistance.
- Resident Carr asked where pipeline would be located. Route has not been finalized due to problems encountered with springs, etc.

There being no further business for consideration, motion was made by Supervisor Gordner, seconded by Supervisor Robbins to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:27pm.
